We are pleased to share excellent news that Milwaukee College Prep "Exceeds Expectations," according to the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction* (DPI). This week, the DPI released school report cards, and across our network of four K-8 schools, MCP received an outstanding rating of 4 stars on all four campuses!

The overall report card scores across all campuses remained the same or increased in the 2022-23 school year when compared to 2021-22. Most notably was the performance of Lloyd Street School, which saw an overall score 13.5 points higher, representing 20.42% growth.

The district and school report cards provided by DPI are intended to create a more standardized methodology for our parents and community members to determine the effectiveness of their local districts and schools. The report cards also include outcomes for each school in four priority areas: Student Achievement, Student Growth, Closing Gaps, and Post-Secondary Readiness.

These high ratings earned across the MCP network reflect the exceptional efforts and commitment of our scholars, staff, and community. MCP is committed to celebrating the gifts of our 2,000+ scholars and eliminating the opportunity gap so that all children gain the knowledge and character to determine their own destinies. A 4-star rating on each of our campuses is proof that all children are capable of great things.
